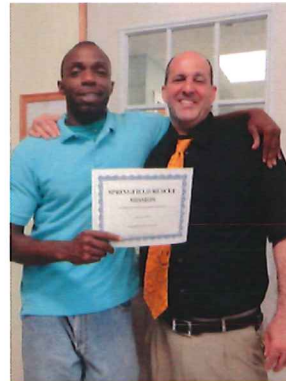

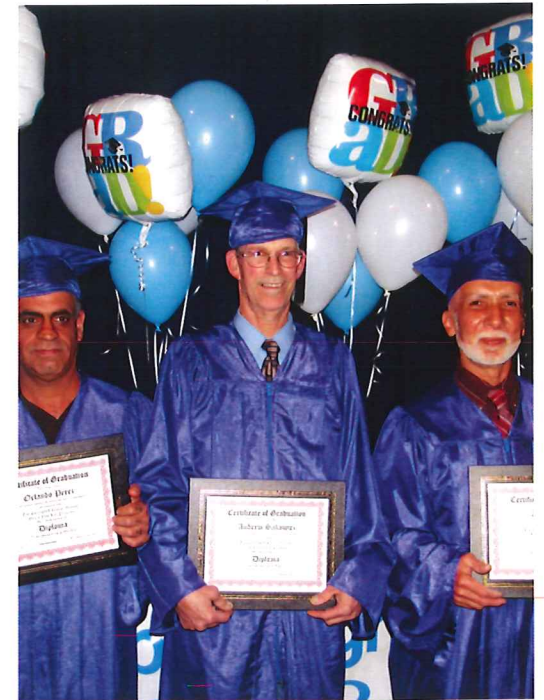

Give-Away Center to 10 Mill Street

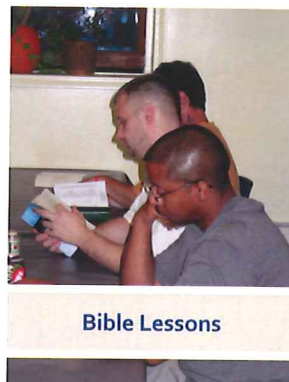

Church Attendance

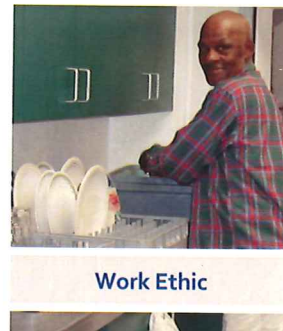
To develop an attitude and practice of worship and fellowship with a local church family.

Pardon and Power Classes

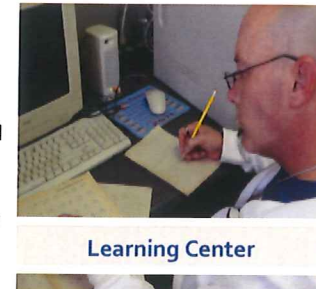
Applying God's Word to help residents face and find victory over addiction.

Transitional Living Facility

Residents who complete the 12-month Biblical & academic curriculum have the opportunity to enter this program for an additional 12 months. They receive, counseling, lodging & meals, assistance in budgeting, finding gainful employment, vocational training, returning to college, making amends with family & taking actions to become productive citizens.
