"It's not easy, trying to be a man in the world," says Dana, a hard worker who fell into depression and drinking when his dreams didn't turn out the way he'd always hoped.

"I'd learned about Jesus when I was little. I went to church, but as soon as I was an adult, I was off to conquer the world," he says. "I didn't know how to deal with setbacks that kept piling up.

"You're supposed to be strong, figure things out and just plow forward," Dana shakes his head, remembering. "I guess my attempt at doing so was just a road to disaster."

That road eventually led him to unemployment, homelessness . . . and hopelessness.

"I no longer felt like I cared anymore—which caused things to crumble more. To cover up those feelings, I *drank* more," Dana admits. "It got really, really bad."

Yet, he discovered Christ had a plan and purpose for his life.

It started at the Rescue Mission.

"I needed somewhere to go," he recalls. Feeling the Lord calling him back to Himself, "I wanted a program with God as the focus, and my brother happened to know one of the pastors here. That's how I ended up coming," Dana marvels. And today, he's turned his life around.

"I've learned that everyone needs Jesus in their life," he nods. "Not just certain people: it's every single person!"
