Angel had no one to count on, nowhere to find "peace on earth." In fact, you may even be shocked by his story . . . years of struggling, isolation, survival on the streets.

As a child, "My life was hard," Angel remembers. Harder still, "My father died when I was 16 years old," he recalls, shaking his head at how much those memories still hurt.

When that happened, Angel found himself easy prey for guys he looked up to in the neighborhood who said they'd take care of him, only to leave him addicted—and alone.

There was "nothing else," he says. "I didn't have family, didn't have anybody." And eventually, the streets became his whole life. It made him tough—but bitter, too . . .

"I felt like nobody loved me," Angel says.

"So I thought I didn't *need* anybody. And in that moment, I didn't care."

But God had other plans for Angel, and he found himself sitting down to a meal surrounded by feelings of hope—at the Rescue Mission, all because of caring hearts like yours. That winter, Angel saw so many other neighbors in need like him come "to get a warm bed, breakfast, dinner, to shower and get clean clothes." And he soon realized he wasn't alone in his suffering anymore.

Just like that, Angel knew it was time—he took the next steps to get clean and sober through our proven New Life Men's Rehabilitation Program. "It's really good—it really works," he smiles. "But you've got to be sure you want to change your life."

Angel wanted that change more than anything, and he's a new man today. He's on staff here at the Rescue Mission, dedicated to helping care for other lives on the line!

"My life has started over because people here gave me love."

And now, Angel is looking out for others. "I talk to the guys. I say, 'if you have no place to live, nowhere to go, there's a program. It can help you because it helped me!"
