The goal of the Springfield Rescue Mission, since 1892, is to meet the physical and spiritual needs of the hungry, homeless ,addicted and less fortunate by Inspiring Hope - Promoting Healing, Sharing the Love of Christ, by helping them apply the Word of God to every area of their lives.

The Springfield Rescue Mission (SRM) is a501(c)3 non-profit organization and is a leader in meeting the needs of the poor and homeless in Greater Springfield.

As an Emergency Shelter, Mobile Feeding Program, Rehabilitation /Transformation Center and Transitional Living Facility, SRM provides food, shelter, clothing, medical attention, Christian counseling, literacy training, workforce development and advocacy – free of charge. These programs help individuals take meaningful steps toward becoming responsible and productive members of the community.

The SRM began as a community outreach ministry located over a laundry facility on Stanford Street in Springfield, MA in 1892. The SRM continues today to provide the homeless and low-income with services to meet their most basic needs, rehabilitation and a safe place of refuge.

Undie Sunday Undie Monday is a time when we ALL can be a blessing to the Men, Women, and Children of Greater Springfield by providing them with brand new underwear. Together, we can make a difference by sharing Christ's love and blessings to those in need.

The Start of USUM

In 1987, a gentleman came through the Rescue Mission doors asking if we knew of a place he could take a shower. We offered him toiletries and directed him to the showers. While he was showering, we took his rags and replaced them with clean, new underwear, a t-shirt and socks, as well as gently used, clean clothing. He appeared from the washroom looking like a new man. This gentleman stayed for a meal and left without ever returning.

A couple years later, the Executive Director received a letter with a donation check inside. It was from our homeless friend. He explained how he never forgot that act of compassion he received at the Springfield Rescue Mission and wanted to pay that forward to others. He had explicit instructions that the money was to be used to buy new underwear for people who came off the streets. It made such a big difference in his life and he knew it would do the same for others.
