Key Achievements

- **Caring Health Center**: Onsite opening enhancing healthcare access for Residents.
- **MassHire Career Coaching**: This ongoing partnership supports Residents on their path to economic prosperity through career coaching and job readiness seminars and searches.
- **GED / HiSET Programs**: Providing education opportunities for residents.
- Tech Foundry Partnership: Collaborating to offer digital skills training.
- **MBI, Comcast, and Lead for America Partnership:** This partnership will allow SRM to be a host site for an American Connection Corps (ACC) member serving as a Digital Equity Practitioner.
- Northstar Program Implementation: Advancing digital literacy and skills in our Learning Center.
- BayCoast Financial Literacy Programs: Supporting residents on their path to financial wellness. Youth
- Workforce Development Opportunities: Partnering with Home City Development, Inc. to provide summer job opportunities for youth in our community.
- Nutritional Quality Improvement: Enhancing the nutritional quality of meals served to residents and the public.

Resident Highlights

- **Road to Wellness:** 35 men are engaged in SRM's recovery program and are being supported on their Path to recovery.
- **Graduation Milestones:** Celebrating the achievements of three graduates in 2023 and five graduates in 2024.
- ServSafe Certification: Two residents obtained ServSafe certification.
- **Postgraduate Education Achievements:** Two Residents and three Resident Assistants are pursuing higher education through Associate and certificate programs.
- **Digital Literacy:** One resident is pursuing a pathway in IT through SRM's partnership with Tech Foundry.
- HiSet: Two Residents have completed SRM's HiSET program.

Events and Community Engagement

- **5K/10K Run to End Homelessness:** We partnered with the Basketball Hall of Fame to provide a Spaghetti Dinner to participants and doubled our attendance this year!
- Fall Taste and See Event: Engaging the community to raise awareness about the root causes of homelessness and what SRM is doing to make a difference.
- Spring Taste and See Event: Showcasing our programs, impact, and vision for the future.
- Major Holiday Meals: Serving over 3,000 residents and community members during three major holiday meals.
- Back to School Backpack Drive: Provided approximately 500 backpacks filled with school supplies to youth in our community.
- **Giveaway Center:** Supporting more than 80 individuals and families weekly, giving them access to free clothing, hygiene items and housewares.
- **Ride to End Homelessness:** Through a collaboration with Sheldon's Harley-Davidson and Trantolo & Trantolo, LLC the SRM is hosting its first ever motorcycle ride!
